

The Flood Genesis 6-7

What did God tell Noah to do?

Genesis 6:14. Make thee an ark ...

Of what was the ark made?

Gopher wood and pitch **Genesis 6:14.** ... of gopher wood; rooms shalt thou make in the ark, and shalt pitch it within and without with pitch.

How big was the Ark?

300x 50 x 30 cubits **Genesis 6:15** And this is the fashion which thou shalt make it of: The length of the ark shall be three hundred cubits, the breadth of it fifty cubits, and the height of it thirty cubits.

How many of each animal was brought on board?

By 7 clean by 2 unclean. **Genesis 7:2-3** 2. Of every clean beast thou shalt take to thee by sevens, the male and his female: and of beasts that are not clean by two, the male and his female. 3. Of fowls also of the air by seven, the male and the female; to keep seed alive upon the face of all the earth.

How long did it rain?

40 days and 40 nights **Genesis 7:4** I will cause it to rain upon the earth forty days and forty nights; and every living substance that I have made will I destroy from off the face of the earth.

How did Noah know it was time to come out of the Ark?

Gen 8:11 And the dove came in to him in the evening; and, lo, in her mouth was an olive leaf pluckt off: so Noah knew that the waters were abated from off the earth.

How long were they on the ark?

Genesis 7:11 In the six hundredth year of Noah's life, on the seventeenth day of the second month--on that day all the springs of the great deep burst forth, and the floodgates of the heavens were opened.
Genesis 7:24 The waters flooded the earth for a hundred and fifty days.
Genesis 7:13-14 By the first day of the first month of Noah's six hundred and first year, the water had dried up from the earth. Noah then removed the covering from the ark and saw that the surface of the ground was dry. ¹⁴. By the twenty-seventh day of the second month the earth was completely dry.

Abraham & The Rise of Israel

The 3 Promises

Genesis 12:2-3 Now the LORD said unto Abram: 'Get thee out of thy country, and from thy kindred, and from thy father's house, unto the land that I will show thee'.² And I will make of thee a great nation, and I will bless thee, and make thy name great; and thou shalt be a blessing:³ And I will bless them that bless thee, and curse him that curseth thee: and in thee shall all families of the earth be blessed.

Great nation - **Genesis 17:19.** And God said, Sarah thy wife shall bear thee a son indeed; and thou shalt call his name Isaac: and I will establish my covenant with him for an everlasting covenant, and with his seed after him.

Genesis 17:4 "You shall be the father of a multitude of nations"

Land - **Genesis 13:14**

all the land which you see, I will give it to you and to your seed forever

Blessing - **Genesis 18:14**

in him all the nations of the earth will be blessed

What was Abraham's reaction to the news that he would have a son?

He Laughed - **Genesis 17:17** Abraham fell upon his face, and laughed, and said in his heart, Shall a child be born unto him that is an hundred years old? and shall Sarah, that is ninety years old, bear ?

What did God command Abraham to do to prove his faith?

Isaac as a Sacrifice - **Genesis 22:2** "...take now thy son, thine only son Isaac, whom thou lovest, and get thee into the land of Moriah; and offer him there for a burnt offering upon one of the mountains which I will tell thee of."

Where did Abraham look for a wife for Isaac?

Back to Abraham's home - **Genesis 24:4** "But thou shalt go unto my country, and to my kindred, and take a wife unto my son Isaac."

The Tribes of Israel Enter Egypt

Who was the favorite son of Joseph?
Why?

Gen 37:3 Now Israel loved Joseph more than all his children, because he *was* the son of his old age:

How did Joseph's brothers dispose of him before they told their father he was eaten by wild beasts?

Gen 37:28 and sold Joseph to the Ishmaelites for twenty *pieces* of silver: and they brought Joseph into Egypt .

Why was Joseph put into jail?

His master's wife falsely accused him of attacking her.
Gen 39:7-20 And Joseph's master took him, and put him into the prison, a place where the king's prisoners *were* bound: and he was there in the prison.

What did Joseph do to gain the favor of the Royal cup bearer?

Gen 40:8 We have dreamed a dream, and *there is* no interpreter of it. And Joseph said unto them, "*Do not* interpretations *belong* to God? Tell me *them*."

What was the meaning of the dreams Joseph heard in jail?

Gen 40:12-13 And Joseph said unto him, This *is* the interpretation of it: The three branches *are* three days: ¹³ Yet within three days shall Pharaoh lift up thine head, and restore thee unto thy place:

Pharaoh had two dreams of skinny cows eating up fat cows and ragged corn devouring healthy corn. What did they foretell?

Gen 41:29-30 ²⁹ Behold, there come seven years of great plenty throughout all the land of Egypt: ³⁰ And there shall arise after them seven years of famine

What happened the first time Joseph's brother's traveled to Egypt?

Gen 42:8-9 And Joseph knew his brethren, but they knew not him. ⁹ And Joseph remembered the dreams which he dreamed of them, and said unto them, Ye *are* spies; to see the nakedness of the land ye are come.

Joseph framed one brother by having his servant put a cup into their pack. Which one? Why?

Benjamin. To test the reaction of the other brothers.

Why did Judah offer himself in Benjamin's place?

To save his father from grief.

Gen 44:31 It shall come to pass, when he seeth that the lad *is* not *with us*, that he will die.

How did Joseph react to Judah's act of self sacrifice?

Gen 45:1-2 ...Joseph made himself known unto his brethren.
² And he wept aloud

The Ten Plagues Exodus 7-11

I Water to Blood - Exodus 7:19 ... Take thy rod, and stretch out thine hand upon the waters of Egypt, upon their streams, upon their rivers, and upon their ponds, and upon all their pools of water, that they may become blood; and that there may be blood throughout all the land of Egypt, both in vessels of wood, and in vessels of stone.

II Frogs - Exodus 8:2-4 ...I will smite all thy borders with frogs: 3 And the river shall bring forth frogs abundantly, which shall go up and come into thine house, and into thy bedchamber, and upon thy bed, and into the house of thy servants, and upon thy people, and into thine ovens, and into thy kneading troughs: 4 And the frogs shall come up both on thee, and upon thy people, and upon all thy servants.

III Gnats or Lice - Exodus 8:16 ...Stretch out thy rod, and smite the dust of the land, that it may become lice throughout all the land of Egypt.

IV Flies - Exodus 8:21 ...I will send swarms of flies upon thee, and upon thy servants, and upon thy people, and into thy houses: and the houses of the Egyptians shall be full of swarms of flies, and also the ground whereon they are.

V Livestock Diseased - Exodus 9:3 ...the hand of the LORD is upon thy cattle which is in the field, upon the horses, upon the asses, upon the camels, upon the oxen, and upon the sheep: there shall be a very grievous murrain.

VI Boils - Exodus 9:8-9 8 ... Take to you handfuls of ashes of the furnace, and let Moses sprinkle it toward the heaven in the sight of Pharaoh. 9 And it shall become small dust in all the land of Egypt, and shall be a boil breaking forth with blains upon man, and upon beast, throughout all the land of Egypt.

VII Thunder & Hail - Exodus 9:18 ...I will cause it to rain a very grievous hail, such as hath not been in Egypt since the foundation thereof even until now

VIII Locust - Exodus 10:4 ... behold, tomorrow will I bring the locusts into thy coast:

IX Darkness - Exodus 10:21-22 21 ...Stretch out thine hand toward heaven, that there may be darkness over the land of Egypt, even darkness which may be felt. 22 And Moses stretched forth his hand toward heaven; and there was a thick darkness in all the land of Egypt three days

X Death of the Firstborn - Exodus 11:4-5 ...About midnight will I go out into the midst of Egypt: 5 And all the firstborn in the land of Egypt shall die, from the first born of Pharaoh that sitteth upon his throne, even unto the firstborn of the maidservant that is behind the mill; and all the firstborn of beasts.

From Egypt to Canaan

How did the Israelites escape the Egyptian army?

Exodus 14:29 But the children of Israel walked upon dry *land* in the midst of the sea; and the waters *were* a wall unto them on their right hand, and on their left. ³⁰ Thus the LORD saved Israel that day out of the hand of the Egyptians

What guided the people after they crossed the Nile?

Exodus 13:21 And the LORD went before them by day in a pillar of a cloud, to lead them the way; and by night in a pillar of fire, to give them light.

What happened at Mount Sinai?

Exodus 32 The people became worried and built a golden cow while Moses was receiving the Ten Commandments. Moses was very angry and broke the tablets the lord gave him... As punishment he had to hand chisel the replacement tablets. The people were ordered never to make golden images to pray to again.

What did God command when the children reached Canaan?

Num 13:1-2 And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying, ² Send thou men, that they may search the land of Canaan, which I give unto the children of Israel:

What did most of the scouts report?

Num 13:28 Nevertheless the people *be* strong that dwell in the land, and the cities *are* walled, *and* very great: ... ³¹We be not able to go up against the people; for they *are* stronger than we

Which scouts disagreed?

Caleb and Joshua **Num 14:6** And Joshua the son of Nun, and Caleb the son of Jephunneh, *which were* of them that searched the land, rent their clothes: ⁷ And they spake unto all the company of the children of Israel, saying, The land, which we passed through to search it, *is* an exceeding good land. ⁸ If the LORD delight in us, then he will bring us into this land, and give it us;

How did God react to the people's fear and doubt?

Num 14:23 Surely they shall not see the land which I swear unto their fathers, neither shall any of them that provoked me see it:

What mistake did Moses do that cost him entrance to the promise land?

Num 20:8 Take the rod... and speak ye unto the rock before their eyes; and it shall give forth his water ¹¹and with his rod he smote the rock twice... ¹² And the LORD .. Because ye believed me not, to sanctify me in the eyes of the children of Israel...

What was Gods punishment for Moses when he disobeyed?

Num 20:12 Because ye believed me not, to sanctify me in the eyes of the children of Israel, therefore ye shall not bring this congregation into the land which I have given them. (KJV)

The Ten Commandments Exodus 20: 2-17

Thou shalt have no other gods before me.

Thou shalt not make unto thee any graven image, or any likeness of any thing that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth.

Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them: for I the Lord thy God am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation of them that hate me; And shewing mercy unto thousands of them that love me, and keep my commandments.

Thou shalt not take the name of the Lord thy God in vain; for the Lord will not hold him guiltless that taketh his name in vain.

Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy. Six days shalt thou labor, and do all thy work. But the seventh day is the Sabbath of the Lord thy God: in it thou shalt not do any work, thou, nor thy son, nor thy daughter, thy manservant, nor thy maidservant, nor thy cattle, nor thy stranger that is within thy gates: For in six days the Lord made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that in them is, and rested the seventh day: wherefore the Lord blessed the Sabbath day, and hallowed it.

Honor thy father and thy mother: that thy days may be long upon the land which the Lord thy God giveth thee.

Thou shalt not kill.

Thou shalt not commit adultery.

Thou shalt not steal.

Thou shalt not bear false witness against thy neighbor.

Thou shalt not covet thy neighbor's house; thou shalt not covet thy neighbor's wife, nor his manservant, nor his maidservant, nor his ox, nor his ass, nor any thing that is thy neighbors.

Entering Canaan - The Promised Land

Where did Moses die?

Deut 34:5 So Moses the servant of the LORD died there in the land of Moab, according to the word of the LORD.

Where was Moses buried ?

Deut 34:6 And he buried him in a valley in the land of Moab, over against Bethpeor: but no man knoweth of his sepulchre unto this day.

How did the Israelites get across the Jordan River?

Josh 3:17 And the priests that bare the ark of the covenant of the LORD stood firm on dry ground in the midst of Jordan, and all the Israelites passed over on dry ground, until all the people were passed clean over Jordan.

How many people did Joshua gather to conquer Ai?

Josh 8:3 So Joshua arose, and all the people of war, to go up against Ai: and Joshua chose out thirty thousand mighty men of valor. (KJV)

Who hid Israel's spies in Jericho?

Josh 2:3-4 And the king of Jericho sent unto Rahab, saying, Bring forth the men that are come to thee, which are entered into thine house: for they be come to search out all the country. ⁴ And the woman took the two men, and hid them, and said thus, There came men unto me, but I wist not whence they were:

Which tribe was not given any land and why?

The Levites were made the priests over all of God's people
Num 3:12 And I, behold, I have taken the Levites from among the children of Israel instead of all the firstborn that openeth the matrix among the children of Israel: therefore the Levites shall be mine

Who led the people after Moses?

Joshua Deut 34:9 And Joshua, the son of Nun, was full of the spirit of wisdom; for Moses had laid his hands upon him: and the children of Israel hearkened unto him, and did as the LORD commanded Moses.

Where did the angel Gabriel first appear in the NT?

Luke 1:9 ...he went into the temple of the Lord... 11...And there appeared unto him an angel of the Lord standing on the right side of the altar of incense.

How did Gabriel react to Zacharias's doubt?

Luke 1:20 ... behold, thou shalt be dumb, and not able to speak, until the day that these things shall be performed, because thou believest not my words,...

What OT father had the same reaction when he was promised a son?

Abraham & Sarah were in the same position as Elisabeth & Zacharias. **Gen17:17** Then Abraham fell upon his face, and laughed, and said in his heart, Shall *a child* be born unto him that is an hundred years old? and shall Sarah, that is ninety years old, bear? **Luke 1:18** I am an old man, and my wife well stricken in years.

How did Mary learn she would bear Jesus?

Luke 1:30-31 And the angel said unto her, Fear not, Mary: for thou hast found favor with God. ³¹ And, behold, thou shalt conceive in thy womb, and bring forth a son, and shalt call his name JESUS.

Why did Joseph accept Mary when he found she was carrying a child?

Matt 1:20 the angel of the Lord appeared unto him in a dream, saying, Joseph, thou son of David, fear not to take unto thee Mary thy wife: for that which is conceived in her is of the Holy Ghost.

Why did Mary and Joseph travel so near the time of Jesus birth?

Luke 2:1 And it came to pass in those days, that there went out a decree from Caesar Augustus, that all the world should be taxed. ³ And all went to be taxed, every one into his own city.

Where did Jesus first sleep?

Luke 2:7 And she brought forth her firstborn son, and wrapped him in swaddling clothes, and laid him in a manger; because there was no room for them in the inn.

Who were the first people to be told of Jesus birth?

Luke 2:8-9 And there were in the same country shepherds abiding in the field, keeping watch over their flock by night. ⁹ And, lo, the angel of the Lord came upon them, and the glory of the Lord shone round about them: and they were sore afraid.

At age 12 Jesus was separated from his parents for 3 days in a strange city. Where did they find Him?

Luke 2:46 And it came to pass, that after three days they found him in the temple, sitting in the midst of the doctors, both hearing them, and asking them questions.

The Gospels: Matthew Mark Luke and John

What was Jesus' first miracle?

John 2:9 the ruler of the feast had tasted the water that was made wine, and knew not whence it was (but the servants which drew the water knew:)

What were the three temptations of Christ?

Luke 4:3 And the devil said unto him, If thou be the Son of God, command this stone that it be made bread.

Luke 4:5-6 And the devil, taking him up into an high mountain, shewed unto him all the kingdoms of the world in a moment of time. ⁶ And the devil said unto him, All this power will I give thee, and the glory of them

Luke 4:9 And he brought him to Jerusalem, and set him on a pinnacle of the temple, and said unto him, If thou be the Son of God, cast thyself down from hence:

Did Jesus promise peace and prosperity to His students?

No. He told them:

Mathew 10: 21-22 And the brother shall deliver up the brother to death, and the father the child: and the children shall rise up against their parents, and cause them to be put to death. 22. And ye shall be hated of all men for my name's sake: but he that endures to the end shall be saved.

What did Jesus say His purpose was?

Luke 19:10 "to seek and save the lost"

And

Mathew 5:17 Think not that I am come to destroy the law, or the prophets: I am not come to destroy, but to fulfill.

The Crucifixion *Luke 22-24*

How did Jesus feel about the things he was about to endure?

Luke 22:42 Saying, **Father, if thou be willing, remove this cup from me: nevertheless not my will, but thine, be done.**

Who betrayed Jesus and how?

Luke 22:48 But Jesus said unto him, **Judas, betrayest thou the Son of man with a kiss?**

Pilot hoped to release Jesus as part of the Passover celebration. What happened?

The Jews chose the release of a murderer over the Son of God. **Luke 23:16** I will therefore chastise him, and release *him*.¹⁷ (For of necessity he must release one unto them at the feast.)¹⁸ And they cried out all at once, saying, Away with this *man*, and release unto us Barabbas:

How did Jesus feel about the people who beat him, reviled him and wrongfully killed him?

Luke 23:34 Then said Jesus, **Father, forgive them; for they know not what they do.**

What happened to Jesus' body after he was declared dead?

Luke 23:52 This *man* [Joseph of Arimathaea] went unto Pilate, and begged the body of Jesus.⁵³ And he took it down, and wrapped it in linen, and laid it in a sepulchre that was hewn in stone, wherein never man before was laid.

Some women went to anoint Jesus on the first day of the week, after observing the Sabbath. What did they find?

Luke 24:2 And they found the stone rolled away from the sepulchre.³ And they entered in, and found not the body of the Lord Jesus

Who were the women that were to tend to Jesus body?

Luke 24:10 It was Mary Magdalene, and Joanna, and Mary *the mother* of James, and other *women that were* with them,

Who besides the women saw Jesus later that day?

Luke 24:13-15 And, behold, two of them went that same day to a village called Emmaus, which was from Jerusalem *about* threescore furlongs.¹⁴ And they talked together of all these things which had happened.¹⁵ And it came to pass, that, while they communed *together* and reasoned, Jesus himself drew near, and went with them.

Jesus appeared to the apostles one was not there. Who was the last apostle to see Jesus?

John 20:24 But Thomas, one of the twelve, called Didymus, was not with them when Jesus came.²⁵ The other disciples therefore said unto him, We have seen the Lord. But he said unto them, Except I shall see in his hands the print of the nails, and put my finger into the print of the nails, and thrust my hand into his side, I will not believe.

The Church Established

To whom were the apostles told to teach the gospel?

Mark 16:15-16 Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. ¹⁶ He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned.

When was it made clear to the apostles that Gentiles were to receive the gospel?

Acts 10:1-48 There was a certain man in Caesarea called Cornelius, a centurion of the band called the Italian *band*, ⁴⁴ While Peter yet spake these words, the Holy Ghost fell on all them which heard the word. ⁴⁵ And they of the circumcision which believed were astonished

How did the eunuch react to having the gospel explained?

Acts 8:35-36 Then Philip opened his mouth, and began at the same scripture, and preached unto him Jesus. ³⁶ And as they went on *their way*, they came unto a certain water: and the eunuch said, See. *here is water*: what doth hinder me to be bantized?

How many missionary journeys did Paul make?

Three, First - Act 13:1 -14:28, Second - Acts 15:36-18:22; Third - Acts 18:23 -21:16

Who were some of Paul's companions on his Journeys?

Barnabas, John, Silas, Timothy, Priscilla and Aquilla, Sopater, Aristarchus and Secundus, Gaius, Tychius and Trophimus.

Where were the apostles when the Holy Spirit fell on them? What day was it?

Acts 1:4-5 ... (Jesus) commanded them that they should not depart from Jerusalem but wait... (to be) baptized with the Holy Spirit...
Acts 2:1-4 And when the day of Pentecost was fully come, they were all with one accord in the same place...

What did Peter answer when the people asked him, "What must we do to be saved?"

Acts 2:38 "Repent and be baptized every one of you for the remission of your sins and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit."

How many people were baptized on that day of Pentecost?

Acts 2:41 They that gladly received his word were baptized; and the same day there were added unto them 3,000 souls.

Who did the Lord add to the church?

Acts 2:47 ...And the Lord added to the church daily such as were being saved.
